INSTRUCTIONS

- Click on the "Scene Sorter" icon.

The "Scene Sorter" window will appear.

This window will not block your cursor's focus so you can move it aside and work as usual with the help of this tool.

In this window you will see:


NEW GROUP

button

- click this button to create a new group.

- Below the "NEW GROUP" button you will find a dropdown menu, there you can see all the nodes that are currently in your scene, select a node from this menu.

- Created groups will appear under this menu.



Select a Node...

- Each group will have a header with three buttons and a line to write a custom name for that group.

button - click to select all of the nodes from this group in the scene.

button - click to remove this complete group. Removing the group will not affect the actual nodes in the scene.

button - when you select a node from the dropdown menu above, click this button to add it to this group. You can add the same node to multiple groups.

- Below the "ADD TO GROUP" button is a text edit line (Change Group Name) where you can write a custom name for this group.
- Below the group name, your added nodes will appear. Clicking on any node will find and select that node in the scene, the selection will be performed without the deselection of already selected nodes (like selecting with the CTRL button pressed).

- On the right side of the added node you will see the M button click this to remove that node from the group. Removing the node from the group will not affect the actual node in the scene.
- At the bottom of the window you can find the if you delete some nodes from your scene, click this button to remove these nodes from all of the groups.
- Basic information about each element in the window is provided by clicking on (What's This?) and then on these elements. This button is in the lower-left corner of the window.

NOTE: Unfortunately, the information in the "Scene Sorter" window can not be saved, so keep that in mind when closing the "Scene Sorter".
